

PRAYER OF ILLUMINATION

EPISTLE READING FAITH COMES BY LISTENING R

ROMANS 10:8-17

¹Brothers and sisters, ⁸The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart (that is, the message of faith that we preach). ⁹Because if you confess with your mouth "Jesus is Lord" and in your heart you have faith that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰Trusting with the heart leads to righteousness, and confessing with the mouth leads to salvation. ¹¹The scripture says, All who have faith in God won't be put to shame. ¹²There is no distinction between Jew and Greek, because the same Lord is Lord of all, who gives richly to all who call on the Lord. ¹³ All who call on the Lord's name will be saved. ¹⁴ So how can they call on someone they don't have faith in? And how can they have faith in someone they haven't heard of? And how can they hear without a preacher? ¹⁵ And how can they preach unless they are sent? As it is written, How beautiful are the feet of those who announce the good news. ¹⁶ But everyone hasn't obeyed the good news. As Isaiah says, Lord, who has had faith in our message? ¹⁷ So, faith comes from listening, but it's listening by means of the word of the Lord.

GOSPEL LESSON PARABLE OF THE SOWER MATTHEW 13:1-9

13 That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat beside the sea. ² Such great crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat there, while the whole crowd stood on the beach. ³ And he told them many things in parables, saying: "Listen! A sower went out to sow. ⁴ And as he sowed, some seeds fell on a path, and the birds came and ate them up. ⁵ Other seeds fell on rocky ground, where they did not have much soil, and they sprang up quickly, since they had no depth of soil. ⁶ But when the sun rose, they were scorched, and since they had no root, they withered away. ⁷ Other seeds fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked them. ⁸ Other seeds fell on good soil and brought forth grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. ⁹ Let anyone with ears listen!"

Hear what the Holy Spirit is telling God's people. For faith comes by listening.


